

Users and groups

Adding an existing user to an existing group

```
usermod -a -G theExampleGroup theExampleUser
```

Changing the primary group of an existing user

```
usermod -g theExampleGroup theExampleUser
```

See wich groups the user belongs to

```
groups theExampleUser
```

Add an existing user to the sudo group

```
usermod -aG sudo username
```

Add a new user with name, shell and home directory

```
sudo useradd -m -c "Samwise the Brave" sam -s /bin/bash
```
